Honored supporters,

It is hard to believe that another year of activities is now behind us. During 2014, we expanded the means by which we inform our supporters (through our new Facebook site), and we made it possible to donate online (through Paypal). In February, during the annual activities update meeting, we honored the young Lithuanian-Americans who volunteered to Lithuania in the summer of 2013 and we held a special fund-raising drive to assist in the renovation of the Vilnius "Vilties angelas" center's rooms that suffered pre-Christmas fire damage. In March, Florida Lithuanian Open golfers donated part of their tournament proceeds to support our organization. With banners (and the help of one former volunteer), "Child's Gate to Learning" was a participant in the Lemont (IL) Lithuanian heritage school's project, "Skurdo skonis" (A Taste of Hunger). During the summer, 3 young volunteers from Kewanee, IL, Oxford, OH, and Indianapolis, IN worked with youths and children from at risk families in Kaunas, Varena and Vilnius. Organization officers and directors, as well as former volunteers visited supported centers during trips to Lithuania. In the fall, we organized the traditional fundraising "Derliaus pietūs" (Harvest Lunch) and were honored that Lithuania's general consul in Chicago, Marijus Gudynas and his family attended. In December, "Child's Gate to Learning" participated in the World Lithuanian Center's Christmas bazaar. Thanks to support of the Lithuanian Foundation, several rural centers were able to organize summer camps. Throughout the year, organization officers wrote fundraiser solicitations and thank you's, maintained contact with supported centers in Lithuania and prepared young volunteers for their work with at risk families in Lithuania. We thank organization support group coordinators who participated in bazaars (in Philadelphia, PA and Washington, D.C.), a take out lunch fund-raiser (in Cleveland, OH) and all other fundraising and information support efforts. We thank all who voluntarily contribute to organization activities.






A SPECIAL FUNDRAISERS/ SPECIAL SUPPORTERS
